3rd–5th Grade Music Elective Program

Dear Parents,

Welcome to the music elective program for 3rd – 5th graders! We are pleased to offer group lessons in fiddle or recorder for 3rd and 4th graders, fiddle, guitar or Taiko drumming for 5th graders, and new this year, clarinet for 4th and 5th graders.

Philosophy

We are providing this program to give students the opportunity to find their own musicality through the various instruments we offer, to build a musical community with one another, and encourage and allow students to be creative with their music. We trust that this program will instill in our students a sense of accomplishment through the rewards of routine practice, performance opportunities, the development of good listening skills and a respect for one another's creative journey in a non-competitive atmosphere. Ultimately our goal is to have our students take joy in playing with one another, as well as with adults, within a musical community.

Performance Opportunities

Performing provides an incentive for excellence, a sense of accomplishment, and the excitement and success of achieving goals. We will use already existing opportunities such as The Winter Revels, as well as other occasions within the school year.

Instruments in class and at home

Students must have an instrument that they can bring to school on elective days, Tuesdays and Thursdays, and bring home with them for practice. The exception to this is Taiko Drums, which the Sensei (instructor) will bring to school. Recorder students must purchase their own recorder, which they can take home with them. For students who do not already own their own instrument we have our own rental program at below-market rates. Please read the rental program information attached to this letter. Rental agreements must be signed and sent back to school with the rental fee attached. **No student will be allowed to bring an instrument home unless a rental agreement has been signed and the appropriate fee has been paid.**

We emphasize that a 30 minute class twice a week on any chosen instrument is not enough time for a child to develop musical ability with that instrument. Instruction is important, but daily handling, playing, and getting accustomed to the instrument is vital to a child's success. We strongly encourage you to ensure that your child spend some time – even as little as 15 minutes – every day devoted to playing their instrument.

Please support your child by providing an instrument for them at home, either through our rental program or by any other means, and encouraging their daily practice.

NCSA has purchased our own instruments to provide students with a lower than market-rate rental and purchase program. Rental/purchase fees are paid annually and based upon the chosen instrument. You will find that these prices are significantly lower than what instrument rental companies charge. The NCSA music director, Heather Grove, and the School of the Arts Educational Foundation will manage all rentals and purchases. Part of the music elective curriculum will be teaching the student how to care for their instrument and developing a sense of responsibility for that instrument. Damages beyond normal wear and tear will be the responsibility of the student and his or her parents.

If you would like to rent an instrument through NCSA, please fill out the Instrument Rental Agreement and return it to the school with your payment attached. **The Rental Agreement and payment must be received by the school before your child may use the instrument in class or take the instrument home.**

Recorders are for purchase only.

Due to the nature of the recorder, students are asked to purchase a recorder for \$5.00, rather than rent their instrument, as it cannot be used again once someone has played it. Recorders may not be used in class or brought home for practice until payment is made.

I understand that the rental period is from **September 1, 2009 through May 18, 2010** and that payments are due on the first day of instruction, prior to a student taking the instrument home.

All instruments MUST be returned on or before the last day of this contract or a replacement fee will be charged. In the event that I return the instrument before the end of the rental period, NCSA will refund rental fees on a pro-rated basis.

I acknowledge receipt of said instrument in good order and condition. I agree to take full responsibility for the instrument and I understand that if any damage occurs to the instrument I am responsible for the cost of repairs or, at the school's discretion, for the cost of replacement of the instrument should it be lost, stolen or damaged beyond repair. Under no circumstances will I attempt to fix the instrument myself.

(Replacement costs: fiddle \$250, guitar \$150, clarinet \$250)

Renter's Instrument Care Responsibilities:

General maintenance of the rental instrument includes teacher-recommended cleaning (teacher will review 1st day of class), keeping case clean, keeping renter's name and phone number inside case, and keeping instrument from undergoing extreme changes in temperature. No instrument should be left outside or kept in a parked car for more than 10 minutes.

Nevada City School of the Arts will make repairs or replace instruments and cases as needed, provided that any necessary repair is the result of normal wear and tear and not due to negligence.

I have read the above rental agreement and care responsibilities and agree to all terms. I am aware that a payment is due at the time of rental, before an instrument can be used in class and taken home, and that I will be responsible for repairs or replacement costs as outlined above.
