

Supply List for 7th and 8th Grade

The following materials will be needed throughout the school year. Please bring them to school on the first day.

- **Pencils** – Lots
- **Pens** –Blue or black ink only, buy a pack. Get a pack of red ones for editing and corrections.
- **Hi-Liter Pens** – 4 – blue, green, yellow, red
- **Paper** – College (or narrow) rule binder paper, several packs.
- **Graph Paper** - 1/4 inch grid graph paper (4 squares to the inch), three hole punched. Two hundred sheets if you are taking Algebra or Pre Algebra.
- **Index Cards** – Pack of 3x5 or 4x6 cards for research projects.
- **Binders** – Get **two** 1 inch binders (not a 2 inch binder).
- **Dividers** - 2 packs of 5 dividers or separators for the binders
- **Pencil case** –flexible plastic or cloth **case** that can fit in binder.
- **Calculator** –Texas Instruments Scientific calculator, or a Casio version. It needs to be a scientific calculator and will last until you need a graphing calculator in high school. Write your name on it with a permanent marker. **Save the directions.**
- **Dictionary** – To keep at **home**. We recommend the paperback American Heritage Dictionary, \$6.50 last year, has the origins of most of the words. Whatever dictionary you buy **must** have word origins (also known as etymology) – the little italicized notes at the end of the definition that tell you whether the word derives from Ancient Norse or Early Modern Arabic, Old Sanskrit, etc.
- **3 Spiral Notebooks** – 3 hole punched.
- **2 composition books** – lined and bound, ask the teacher if you are not sure.
- **Scissors**
- **Ruler**

Optional: **Pencil Sharpener** – and **Water Bottle** – Small, refillable, leak-proof
